A note about the disinfectant tablets we're closing out.

When our sister company Chlorfexis, LLC, existed, it was an EPA-registered subregistrant of a chemical company and was authorized to sell disinfectant tablets with Chlorfexis labeling. This is a highly legal relationship that was expensive to apply for and maintain.


Once Chlorfexis, LLC, ceased to exist as a business entity, we were required to end our EPA subregistration and were no longer legally allowed to put Chlorfexis labels on our bottles. Every word, image and space of the label was authorized by the EPA, but we were required to abandon our labeling.

As such, the tablets we're closing out have the chemical company's house brand on them: EfferSan. Same tablets, same chemical composition, different label.

Even though we're no longer the chemical company's EPA subregistrant, we're still bound by pricing restriction agreements, and are in full compliance with them.

We hope this clears up any confusion. Thank you for your understanding.
